

WINDSOR CASTLE BEER FESTIVAL 2014

The following ales are all in the Cottage Room, a good selection of ales from micro breweries nationwide which we hope you will enjoy.

1648 Brewery, E. Sussex: Ruby Mild 3.6%

Ruby coloured & mild on the palate. Smooth & gently hopped with plenty of body.

Kirkby Lonsdale, Lancs: Tiffin Gold 3.6%

Low in strength, full of flavour, brewed using bucket loads of hops giving a smooth citrus mouth & nose feel.

Elgoods, Cambs: Spring Challenge 3.7%

Very pale refreshing light colour beer.

Dorking Ales: Smokestack Lightning 4%

A beech smoked ale made with imported smoked malt & American hops.

Elland, W. Yorks: Lambo's First Pint 4%

An enticing ruby beer with a bitter taste derived from a blend of 3 American hops.

Hop Studio, Poling W Sussex: This England 4%

Crisp hoppy pale tan bitter with pleasant biscuit malt.

Great Newsome, Hull: Ploughman's Pride 4.2%

Dark rich malty ale with liquorice tones

Hopback, Wilts: Spring Zing 4.2%

Veritable hop festival in a glass! Pioneer, Goldings, Saaz Tettnang & Styrian Goldings are used to flavour a brew made from maize, wheat & barley malts. A really pale & aromatic session – pleaser.

Belleville Brewing Co. London: Northcote Blonde 4.2%

Crisp & fruity, golden & scintillating, this ale thinks it's a lager & with Liberty hops from the U.S. & Saaz from Czech Republic, it delights & confounds in equal amounts.

Surrey Hills, Dorking: Shere Drop 4.2%

Pale in colour, grapefruit & lemon in the aroma. Wonderful hoppiness complemented by balanced malt flavour. Long finish – moderately dry.

Wharfebank, W.Yorks: Golden Ticket 4.5%

Hidden beneath a smooth creamy head this is a luscious dark beer flavoured with chocolate

Surrey Hills, Dorking: Greensand IPA 4.6%

This is a hop monster. Despite a relatively modest abv for an IPA, this beer delivers an explosion of hops in every sense. A very special beer.

Exe Valley, Devon: It's Phil's Ale 4.8%

A deep golden beer brewed with Devon malt & a zillion hop flavours from Cluster, Magnum, Bobek, Challenger & Cara hops.

Belleville Brewing Co. London: Battersea Brownstone 4.8%

An U.S. style brown ale. Fruity & nutty with caramel & toffee from the chocolate & crystal malts & a little spice from the Bullion & Willamette hops. Sounds like your favourite dessert

Beachy Head, Sussex: Legless Rambler 5%

Traditional bitter, excellent balance, hop bitterness & malt sweeteners. 2012 and 2013 winner Eastbourne Beer Festival.

Hammerpot, N.Yorks: Obsidian 5%

Well structured black IPA with notes of grapefruit, dark but unexpectedly refreshing.
